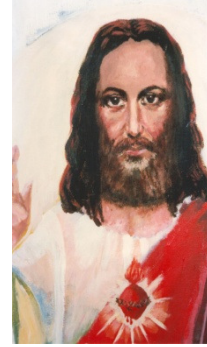

Theme

Pope John Paul the Great Catholic High School is pleased to announce an art exhibition and competition entitled, *Through Him, With Him, In Him, One in Christ*.

Competition

The exhibition will be juried by members of The Foundation for Sacred Arts, a Catholic non-profit organization that promotes beauty in the sacred arts for the glory of God and the transformation of culture. Decisions made by the jury are final.

Best of Show, First place, and Runner-up will be awarded certificates by the jury in each of two categories; middle school (grades 6-8) and high school (grades 9-12).

Selection Criteria

The exhibition's jurors will select the strongest artworks available to them, in terms of both subject and technique. The submission process will be anonymous.

Media and Size Restrictions

Submissions of artworks in any artistic media are welcome. Works submitted must not exceed 46"x60" and should weigh no more than 50 pounds.

Eligibility and Subject Restrictions

Each work must be completed by a student (6th-12th grade, public/private/diocesan/home-schooled) who resides within the Arlington Diocese.

Religious works of art which draw their inspiration from the theme *Through Him, With Him, In Him, One in Christ* may be submitted. Images that are inappropriate, derogatory, disrespectful of the faith or that are not explicitly religious will not be considered.

Submission Guidelines

Digital images of each work (jpeg format) must be submitted electronically no later than March 31, 2010 to william.oconnor@jpthegreat.org. For sculpture, please send 3 different views of each piece.

Submission must include Name, Grade, School, Address, Phone, Number of pieces submitted, Title, Medium and Dimensions of each piece. There is a limit of four entries per student.

Submission Deadline: March 31, 2010.

Exhibition:

Artists will be notified of selected works no later than April 16, 2010. Works selected for the exhibit must be delivered to Pope John Paul the Great Catholic High School, Dumfries, Virginia, no later than April 24, 2010.

All selected works must be matted and framed, with the exception of three-dimensional works or works painted on artist canvas with stretcher boards, which should be framed.

Works will be exhibited from April 30- May 31, 2010. Each selected work will remain in the exhibit for the duration of the show. No work is for sale. At the close of the show, works may be retrieved at Pope John Paul the Great Catholic High School beginning June 1, 2010.
